Goodrich Village Hall has recently secured £50,000 for alternative technologies from the Low Carbon Building Program & the Community Sustainable Development Programme. The technologies include. Solar Thermal, Solar PV, and Air Source Heat Pumps.

Further energy saving measures have been taken with the financial help of Awards For All, Herefordshire Grass Roots and the Severn Waste Environmental Fund. This £20,000 of funding has been used to install an insulated suspended ceiling with energy saving lighting, Argon Double Glazing, an Insulated Wooden Floor, Cavity Wall & Loft Insulation.

We have a guest speaker lined up from 'Green Communities', who will give us a basic overview of the renewable technologies, we also have our contractors lined up ready for questions and advise.
