What will a Choice and Control Champion do?

The Champions will represent **all** groups involved in delivering personalisation – this includes people who use services, their carers, staff working in provider services, staff working in community services, staff working in support services, advocacy groups and voluntary groups etc.

Champions will receive training and support and will be a communication link for the Choice and Control programme. This means that they need to share information with others they come into contact with; they need to pass on any views from those people and ideas or comments to help make sure that the changes the programme makes are the right ones.
